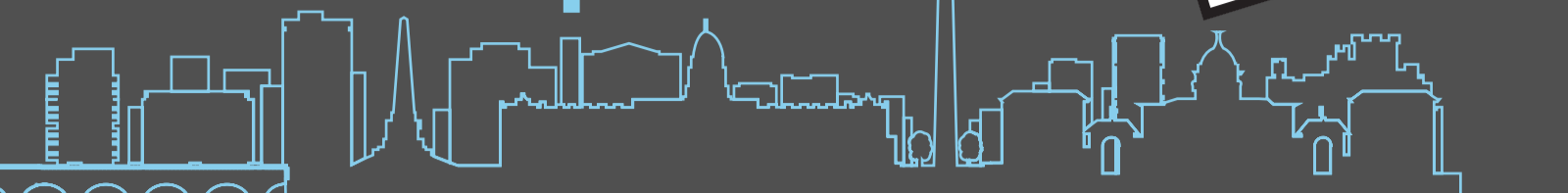
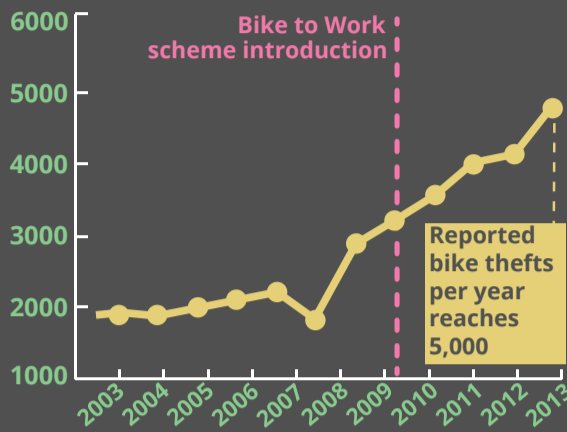


Dublin Bike Theft Report

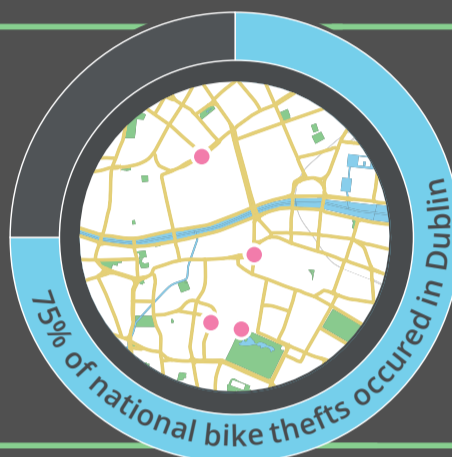
Between **2003 & 2013** recorded bike theft has increased by **100%**
 Theft rose in **2009** along with the introduction of the **Bike to Work** scheme



But Crime Victim Surveys show that only 1 in 4 bike thefts are reported to the Gardai

So in 2013: The true number of bikes stolen in Dublin was estimated to be at least **20,000**

Dublin Hotspots include:

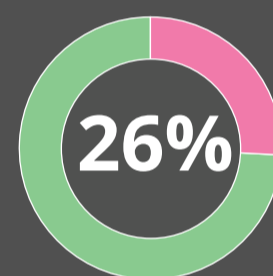
- Grafton / Georges St Quarter
