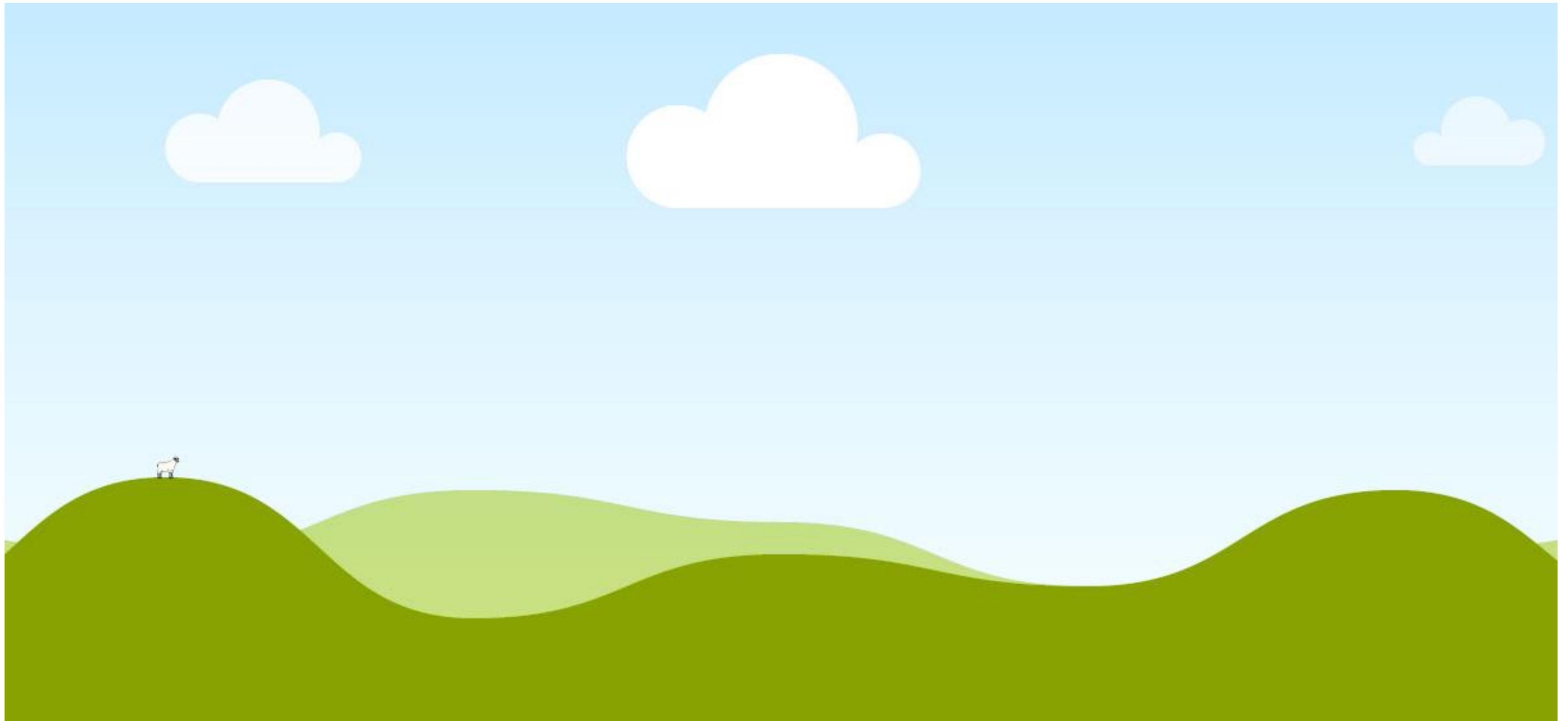


Cycle South Dublin Programme

Cycle South Dublin Programme

Cycle South Dublin (CySD) was adopted in 2021 and proposes a set of 45 routes that will deliver over 260km of new and improved cycle lanes over a ten-year period. Many of the routes will be divided into smaller, more manageable projects, to ensure delivery on a phased basis.

Budget and Resources

Expenditure of €10.9M in 2021, of €15.5M in 2022 and €22.33M in 2023. The NTA has provided a funding allocation for 2024 of €22.5m, this will be augmented by SDCC of up to €5m in LUPT levies to ensure that the programme remains on track.

Cycle South Dublin Programme

45 different projects are being progressed in 2024 using the funding available from the NTA and SDCC.

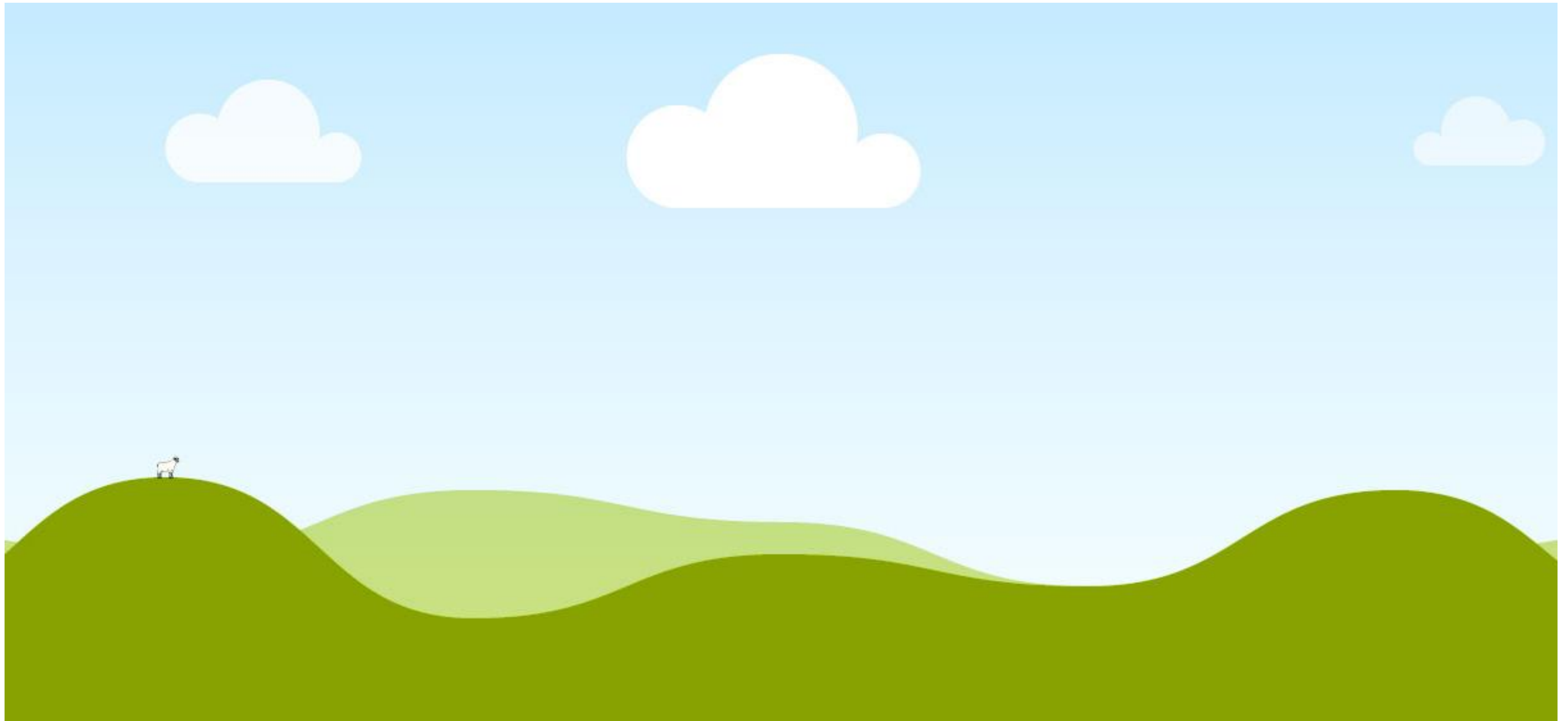

D24 Neighbourhood

Network Phase 1

Complete. 5.5 km of segregated cycle lanes on reallocated road space. Narrowing of road to reduce speeding. 7 Schools within 500 metres of the scheme. Improved bus and pedestrian facilities.

Official opening 5th July.

Value approx €4m



Limekiln Lane D12 Bike Bus

Complete. Safe route to school scheme identified along the route of the D12 Bike Bus which starts in the DCC area and ends at the Riverview ETNS on Limekiln Road. Official opening 27th June
Value approx €1.5m



School Streets

Clondalkin,
Palmerstown,
Tallaght.

Complete. Schemes to provide safer areas, traffic and speed reductions outside schools on Old Nangor Road (Clondalkin), The Oval (Palmerstown) and Springfield (Tallaght)
Value approx €1.2m



Castletymon Phase 1a

Complete. Part of SDCC DoT Pathfinder project. First phase of Castletymon Road scheme, north of the completed district centre. Connects Tymon Park and Local school.

Value approx €1m
